


Tian Sheng Street Street Market Concept

Solution Concept


The name of the project has been taken from the street itself to enrich the culture surrounding a traditional market that is already known by its name.

The concept behind the improvements is to **value an ancient custom** and Chinese traditions, innovating with **organization** and more **comfort** for customers and vendors. The street is already great and used by thousands everyday, the goal of this project is **only to improve** and make this daily use **greater**.

Based on **local elements**, **shapes**, **materials** and **culture**, the project aims not to be a disturbance, the street is already full of visual elements and noise. **Calm colors** and **simple shapes** aim **not to overwhelm** this crowded view.

Blocking the crossing to cars aims to make everyone more comfortable in this space. The street is kept open to bicycles, street vendors and emergency vehicles, guiding them along a pleasant path that is served by a new series of urban furniture around them.

Planning




To improve the **flow of people, bikes and service carts**, the street will be on the **same level**, turning it into a **big sidewalk**, making it more **accessible** oriented mostly for people.

To **organize** the spacing, it was made a **pathway** to divide places for the **marketers to expose** the products and/or to prepare the street food that is sold and the people to walk with **different pavements** for the path and for where the **vendor tent** will be. In the night, linear **built-in lights** on the floor will indicate the way for the **pedestrians**.

The **revetment** of the street will be made of **permeable pavement**, in **light colors**, to **reinforce the albedo** and **enhance** the amount of light on the local.

Multipurpose Tent

Due to the absence of organization during the daily sales that makes the **passing of people** difficult, we create a **multipurpose vendor tent**, a tent that facilities the practical of sell and **standardization** in all the street.

The **geometric pattern** used are inspired by **classical Chinese** workmanship, referring to the old culture, very present in the area, and to the unique dynamic of the location.

This **series of tents** will fill the street and great a more organized place, each vendor can **use it as it pleases**, making each of them **unique**. All this news tents will great a **better place** for the vendors that don't have a **proper space** at the moment.


All of this will make this already great market only more usable and rich in options to its daily guests. Making the street an even greater place to visit and shop around.



Resting Spot

The **Resting Spot** is made up of a group of **benches** arranged around a beautiful **natural rock**. This central element of the whole project is the perfect place to **rest/eat** during your time on the street for people **passing by**, all **residents** and **street vendors**. The rock brings **nature**, **protects** the pedestrian and calms traffic, a **natural** material contrasting with the **geometrical** seats. Creating a place that encourages a **reflective place** and guides everyone to **walk around** the street.





Wooden Portals

These large wooden gates create **barriers** that create a more **controlled environment**, enhancing the streets wayfinding and the market as a whole. Using **local woods** designed for outdoor use, *Camphor Wood and Paulownia Wood*, these pieces **organize** the street entrances without blocking natural light or obstructing the view. Their base is united the planting of a with a **local plant vine**, *Parthenocissus Tricuspidata*, that throughout the years will grow bringing more **nature and life**.




Bike Racks




Wooden Organizers

These wooden dividers create and **organize** spaces for **trash** cans and **motorcycles**. Organizing a more **unique**, proper and **clean** place for these items, leaving the street more **open** and **comfortable** for pedestrians.
